BLANKET CABINETS

Now that fall is almost here, it is time to think about blanket season again. Please go to your blanket hook and pull down all of your blankets. Send out those that need clean and repair. Toss those that have lived beyond their usefulness. Store in your trunks the heavy ones that we hope not to need for at least 2 or 3 more months. Dust off the lightweight waterproof one that your horse can live in on the coming cooler evenings and during fall showers. Please store the rest at home or in a trunk upstairs. Thank you.
